**NOTICE**

**Subject:- Declaration of Marks of online examination (Tier-II) held on 04.03.2024 for the Post Junior Engineer (Electrical)/Section Officer (Electrical) in various Department under post code-802/22 & Calling of e-dossiers from the shortlisted candidates -regarding.**

The candidates may please refer to the DSSSB advertisement No. 02/22 dated 31.12.2021 with closing date 09.02.2022 read with the notice No. 162-169 dated 03.02.2022, Notice-cum-addendum No. 935-940 dated 02.03.2023, corrigendum No. 2030-37 dated 07.08.2023, corrigendum No. 2038-43 dated 07.08.2023, corrigendum dated 25.01.2024 and other corrigendum/addendum, if any, in respect of post code-802/22 available on Board's website, advertising **109 vacancies (UR-41, EWS-12, OBC-35, SC-14, ST-07 including PwBD: OH-03, HH-08, MD-01, ExSM-01)** for the post of **Junior Engineer (Electrical)/Section Officer (Electrical)** in various Department under post code-802/22 under Combined Examination Scheme.

2. Further, after unification of North DMC, South DMC and East DMC as Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) w.e.f. 22.05.2022, all results of North DMC, South DMC and East DMC will be declared in the name of Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) as per notice dated 02.03.2023.

3. Vide Notice cum Corrigendum for the Post Codes advertised under Combined Examination Scheme, issued by the DSSSB vide No. 5070-81 dated 19.02.2024, it has to be ensured that – **“The candidate must exercise at least one preference for a Post. Candidates, who do not submit their Post Preference (s) within the stipulated time, will not be considered for any Post in the final result. Such candidates shall not be provided another opportunity to exercise preference for Posts”**. Further, **“Final selection and allocation of department by DSSSB shall be based on merit cum preference only. The User Department shall check the eligibility as per RRs and other terms and conditions of the Advertisement Notice”**.

4. Further, following points must be kept in mind before exercising the option in the dossier:

- a. ***As per the Board (DSSSB) resolution dated 14.7.2022, DSSSB shall neither undertake scrutiny of documents uploaded by the shortlisted candidates in their e-dossier nor check the eligibility of the candidates as per the Recruitment Rules for the post or the terms and conditions stipulated in the Vacancy Notice relating to age, experience, educational qualification,***

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reserved category status, PwD status etc. These will be checked by the User Department at the time of Document verification for deciding the eligibility of the candidate for the post. The candidates should therefore ascertain their eligibility as per RR and the terms and conditions of the Vacancy Notice and indicate their preference for those Posts/Departments only for which they are eligible.

- b. Final Merit list will be prepared on the basis of overall performance of candidates in Tier-II Examination held on 04.03.2024.
- c. The result will be declared only once by the DSSSB and no further nomination of candidates would be made, in the event of candidates not joining/not found eligible, subsequent to the conduct of Document Verification by the User Departments. In such cases, the Departments may take further action regarding carrying forward of vacancies in accordance with the extant rules. There shall not be any Waiting List/ Reserve List after declaration of Final Result.
- d. Final selection of candidates, in each category, will be made on the basis of overall performance in Tier-II Examination and preference of posts exercised by them. Once the candidate has been given his first available preference, as per his merit, he will not be considered for any other option. Candidates are, therefore, required to exercise preference of posts very carefully. The option/ preference once exercised by the candidates will be treated as FINAL and IRREVERSIBLE. Subsequent request for change of allocation/ service by candidates will not be entertained under any circumstances/ reasons. The final allotment of posts is made on the basis of merit-cum-preferences of Posts/ Departments given by the candidates and once a post is allotted, no change of posts will be made by the DSSSB due to non-fulfillment of any post specific requirements as per RRs or any other terms and conditions stipulated in the Vacancy Notice relating to age, experience, educational qualification, reserved category status, PwBD status etc. In other words, for example, if a candidate has given higher preference for a post and is selected for that post, in that case, if he fails to meet the RR qualifications or any other terms and conditions stipulated in the Vacancy Notice relating to age, experience, educational qualification, reserved category status, PwBD status etc, his candidature will be rejected by the user department and he will not be considered for any other posts/departments by DSSSB.
- e. Options once submitted shall be treated as final and will not be changed subsequently under any circumstances. Therefore, candidates must be careful in exercise of such options. Any grievance received in this regard in any form like Post, Fax, Email, by hand, etc. shall not be entertained by the DSSSB.







f. As per the detailed Advertisement Notice No 02/22 dated 31.12.2021 available on DSSSB website for the combined exam for different Departments, the posts are identified suitable for certain categories of PwBD in some Departments and not in all the Departments. Therefore, due caution must be exercised by PwBD candidates at the time of indicating their preferences for the Departments. In case they give preference for a Department where the post is not identified suitable for their category of disability and the DSSSB allocates that Department on basis of merit cum preference, then in such a case his candidature shall be liable to be rejected by the User Department and the candidate will not be considered for any other post.

5. For the convenience of candidates, the Department wise vacancy position alongwith detailed nomenclature of the posts is tabulated as: -

6. The result of online Tier-I examination held on 22.06.2022 was declared vide Notice dated 14.11.2023 and 1035 candidates were shortlisted for appearing in Tier-II exam. However, vide notice dated 22.02.2024, the candidature of 08 EWS category candidates was withdrawn due to reduction in vacancies of EWS category in DTL and hence, the number of shortlisted candidates remained 1027 instead of 1035. The Tier-II examination was conducted on 04.03.2024.

7. The marks obtained by **540 candidates** who appeared in Tier-II written examination held on 04.03.2024 has been uploaded on Board's website. Candidates

can view their marks by logging in to their account in OARS module on [www.dsssbonline.nic.in](http://www.dsssbonline.nic.in).

8. Based on the performance in the examination, 245 candidates who have secured equal or more marks in their respective category as per details given below in the table have been provisionally shortlisted to upload e-dossier subject to attaining minimum qualifying marks and correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms:-

9. Further, since documents have not been called from the candidates along with the application forms as such detailed scrutiny regarding eligibility has not been carried out, and therefore, mere inclusion of names in the list of candidates shortlisted for uploading of e-dossier does not entitle them any right over the post.

10. Reserved Category candidates who have obtained marks above or equal to the last shortlisted UR Candidates have been shortlisted against UR vacancies and their final selection to the post shall be considered in UR Category, subject to availability of vacancies, otherwise for selection in their respective category.

11. As per the Examination Scheme, notified vide advertisement no. 02/22, the Tier-I exam was qualifying in nature. The evaluation of Tier-II exam has been done based on the cumulative marks of Part I and II. The selection will be made on the basis of marks obtained in Tier-II exam. The final allocation of Posts/Departments will be made on the basis of merit cum preference. Hence, the candidates who have scored equal to or more than the cut off marks and shortlisted for uploading documents in e-dossier are informed to give their preferences for the Posts/Departments in serial order in the e-dossier. Before exercise of such option they must satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post as per the RRs and the terms and conditions stipulated in the Advertisement Notice and related Corrigendum/Addendum for the posts.

12. The **PREFERENCE FORM** is available in OARS Module and needs to be filled by the candidate at the time of filling the e-dossier. The candidate has to take out print of the same and upload it duly signed by him/her in e-dossier link in OARS. **The candidate has to compulsorily exercise at least one preference in Preference Form, otherwise he/she will not be considered for any Post /Department. The candidate will be considered only for the selected preference**



**of Department in order, as per their merit. No other preference of department will be considered if he/she does not select the preference in that department.**

13. The shortlisted candidates for the above-mentioned post/post code are hereby informed to fill the e-dossier along with the preference form and upload the documents relating to Educational Qualifications/Experience Certificates/Caste Certificate/Proof of Govt. Servant/Ex Servicemen/ Admit Cards, Preference Form etc., as applicable in the e-dossier module in OARS link in their individual accounts in OARS module.

14. Kindly note that the e-dossier link will be activated to only those candidates who have been provisionally shortlisted to upload e-dossier as per details given above.

15. **The e-dossier link shall be active from 16/07/2024 to 30/07/2024.**

16. The above shortlisted candidates are also being separately informed through SMS and e-mail on their registered mobile number and e-mail ID **as an additional facility only**. If any candidate fails to upload the e-dossier and preference form during the above said period, his/her candidature will be rejected and no further opportunity will be given on whatsoever ground.

17. **Mere asking the candidate for up-loading documents in the e-dossier module does not confer upon him any right to selection to the applied post. Allocation of Posts / Departments will be made purely on the basis of merit-cum-preference against the notified vacancies. The final selection / appointment to the post will be done by the User Department provided the candidate falling in the zone of consideration fulfills all the required eligibility conditions. It is reiterated that if the candidate fails to upload his documents on or before the date as mentioned above he will not be given any further opportunity and his candidature will be treated as cancelled.**

18. The above shortlisting of candidates for calling of e-dossier and filling up preference form for the post code mentioned above will be subject to outcome of pending court cases; if any.

19. While every care has been taken in preparing the list of shortlisted candidates, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions if any, detected at any later stage.
